

The WaterSense New Homes Incentive Program Fact Sheet 2016

About the Incentive

Cascade Water Alliance and **Built Green** are excited to provide the **WaterSense New Homes Incentive Program**, which offers a **\$1,000** per unit rebate to builders who construct homes that meet the following requirements:

- ❖ Single-family or multi-family projects
- ❖ Located in Cascade Water Alliance's territory
- ❖ WaterSense New Homes certified
- ❖ Built Green 3-star certified or higher

Please Note: Up to 100 rebates will be offered in 2016. No single builder can receive more than 20 rebates during the year. The rebate will not be provided until both WaterSense New Homes and Built Green certification are met and verified.

How to Obtain the Incentive

We want to make the process of achieving this incentive as administratively easy as possible. To enroll your project, submit to Built Green a Project Enrollment Form as well as the WaterSense Incentive Addendum which alerts Built Green you will be targeting both certifications.

Once both certifications have been issued, Built Green will provide Cascade Water Alliance with the necessary materials. Cascade Water Alliance will then issue the rebate to the builder. Built Green and Cascade will work together as partners to make this process easier for you.

About the Partners

WaterSense is a national program sponsored by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency that promotes water efficiency and enhances the market for water-friendly programs, products, and practices.

Cascade Water Alliance is a municipal corporation composed of seven cities and water districts that is a wholesale water provider. Cascade is also a WaterSense partner, offering various incentives under the program.
